PROGRAM INFORMATION FOR BRASS, WOODWIND, PERCUSSION STUDENTS

Beginning lessons will be given on these instruments: flute, clarinet, saxophone, trumpet or cornet, French Horn, trombone, *drums. (*Needs approval of instructor.)

The following are explanations of "Instructional Levels":

- Beginner: Students who are starting a band instrument for the first time. Students may begin lessons the summer after 4th grade.
- Elementary: Students who have started any instrument within the year, and are in Accent on Achievement Book 1.
- Intermediate: Students who are already playing an instrument and are in Accent on Achievement Book 2.
- Advanced: Students who are in Book 3 or higher.

INFORMATION FOR BEGINNERS:

1. Instruments - Brass and Woodwind

If student does not own or have access to an instrument, one must be rented from a local music store. Check the yellow pages under "Musical Instruments". It is always best to rent an instrument for a three month period. (Some stores have different time plans.)

2. Instruction Books

The following book(s) need to be purchased by beginning students for appropriate instrument:

Brass, Woodwinds: **Accent on Achievement Book 1 with CD (it is sold as a set) by John O'Reilly and Mark Williams**

Drums: Combined Percussion Book 1 (spiral bound) **Accent on Achievement Book 1 with CD (it is sold as a set) by John O'Reilly and Mark Williams**

3. Additional Supplies

Clarinets and Alto Sax LaVoz (med) or Rico Royal #2 reeds, Van Doren #2 (for saxophone only) reeds are generally considered to be a good name brand of reeds. Buying six at a time would assure a good reed supply and prevent extra trips to a music store. Cork grease and a cleaner swab for both saxophone and clarinet.

Trumpet, Cornet: Valve oil

Trombones: Slide oil or slide grease

Drums: Drum Kit (which consists of) Practice Pads, Bells, sticks, mallets. This should be rented.

A music stand should be purchased so the music can be seen comfortably.
IMPORTANT!!

All students should bring instrument and book to the first lesson.

INFORMATION FOR STRING STUDENTS

LEVEL OF INSTRUCTION

Beginner: Students who are starting a string instrument for the first time. (Students may begin lessons this summer if they have completed grade 3.)

Elementary: Students currently using String Builder, Book 1. (New book needed for Summer lessons-Artistry in Strings)

Intermediate: Students currently using Suzuki Books for various grade levels.

Advanced: The student should have a rudimentary knowledge of positions other than first and be acquainted with various bowing techniques.

INSTRUMENT: Violin - Viola - Cello -Bass

Beginners will be loaned instruments (violin's and viola's) at no charge insofar as they are available. (Local music stores also have rental plans for most all instruments.)

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES:

Students using privately owned or rental instruments must obtain a soft foam sponge (approximately 3" x 6") and rubber band for a shoulder rest.

Rosin for bow.

A music stand for practicing at home.

IMPORTANT!

All students should bring instrument and book to the first lesson.

The following books will need to be purchased by Beginners:

1. Beginner: Artistry In Strings Book 1 (with CD's) for appropriate instrument).
For bass students purchase the Low Position of Artistry In Strings.
2. Elementary: Students who have completed using String Builder Book 1, should purchase Artistry In Strings Book 2 (with CD's).
